





## Mapping Activity

## Guide

- 1. Using the "Map it Out" proforma, you can either:
- Carry out a team meeting activity where as a group, you generate as many examples of outings relevant to your area.
- Go on a "team walk" around the local area noting down potential outings and learning experiences. This is also a great opportunity to build community links.
- 2. Use the **"Possible Lines of Direction"** proforma to plan possible experiences ensuring that you involve children, colleagues, parents and the wider community.
- Consider planning sessions with the children
- Use the PLOD as an opportunity to reflect on benefits, challenges and risks
- Consider resourcing, cost, continuous and enhanced provision
- Link back to home learning opportunities
- The PLOD is an ongoing reflection tool and can work well as a "working wall" using a whiteboard or within a portfolio. Don't be afraid to get creative.
